The Unstoppable Worshipper

Faced with opposition, danger or even death, they just keep going. We're told of worshippers in the Early Church who, more than simply enduring, actually rejoiced "because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name" (Acts 5:41). Are you distracted in your worship times with others? Stay focused on the One who deserves our full attention. Never stop loving Jesus, creatively letting Him know how wonderful He is. Whether you're home alone or part of the congregation on Sunday morning, never stop worshipping our awesome God!
