

The Story of God: The Bible as Narrative
Act 3 – The Divided Kingdom – A study of Ahab
Community Life Group Questions

Let's get a sense of what the Southern Kings of Israel were like.

1. Recount together the Story of Ahab and Elijah together from Sunday's sermon from I Kings 16-18. What is your perspective on Elijah when he runs south? Has he lost faith? Has he lost perspective? If so, why does God feed him and help him rest? Is God enabling him then? For a guy that we might think is losing perspective, where does he go? Then is this losing perspective? If we weaken, but we run to TOWARDS God, what do you think He makes of this?

2. Have you ever had this experience? Share with the group a time or times when you feel like you have or are losing your perspective? Was there a brokenness and a realization that you needed God? Have you "run to Mt Horeb" in the midst of your supposed "loss of perspective or faith? How might this subtle change in thinking change your heart/mind about where you are at during this time?

3. After ALL Ahab had done wrong, why does God seemingly blow His top on him over stealing Naboth's field? What does this say to us about our Father?
