**Community Life Group Questions**

1. Read Deuteronomy 6:1-15. Of all the things Moses could have said at the end of his life to the children is Israel, he picks REMEMBER? Why? What is the connection to us? What could he have emphasized?  
Remember = to MARK, to mention, to recount, to record, to think on. How do you this this? What are some ways that are effective?
  
2. Read Deuteronomy 8:1-0. List the things that God does for Israel. In verse 10, again what does God, of all things, call Israel to do here when they are satisfied? Why? What dynamic does this have on us?
  
3. Read Deuteronomy 8:11-20. What is God's main warning in verse 11? Again, what is God's solution to either fixing or avoiding this problem? In verses 17-18, we see that word autonomy again? How so?
