Community Life Group Questions

1. Let's start with a review. Can you someone name the various "threads" we have discussed so far and what they are? How about the 3 main words we have camped on in the Narrative and what they mean and why they are significant? How about how and why Jesus is "Central" to the Story from what we have discussed? Now, have someone retell the Story so far, Act by Act, Scene by Scene.

2. Read Exodus 1:1-20. What do you read into this deal with the mid-wives in verses 15-20? Given what we have discussed about God's Story thus far, how does this fit? Why is this SO significant to see this story inside the larger story so early on?

3. Read Exodus 6:1-8. There is just a TON here. List out and share what your observations are from these verses? How and why does God refer to Himself differently from here on? What moves God? What is God like from these verses that we can count on like Israel? Read verse 9. What is happening here and what does this say to US?
